



CODE OF CONDUCT – LEEDS RHINOS – COACH

- Conduct yourself in an honest, fair, impartial and transparent manner.
- Encourage athletes to learn the England Netball rules and follow them.
- Abide by England Netball policies and procedures.
- Ensure you know the date, time and venue of training sessions and matches.
- Arrive in plenty of time for training and matches.
- Publicly accept official judgements.
- Discourage unfair play and dissent with officials, volunteers and others.
- Never force players to take part in sport.
- Set a good example for athletes.
- Treat everyone equally regardless of any protected characteristic.
- Respect confidentiality and follow GDPR on sensitive information.
- Uphold the reputation of Leeds Rhinos netball
- Wear clean and smart designated Leeds Rhinos coaching kit.
- Ensure equipment is present at sessions that it is in good order and first aid kit restocked.
- Do not bring the sport into disrepute by making inappropriate comments verbally or on social media.
- Never abuse the position of power, influence and trust held as a coach.
- Welcome new athletes and encourage integration into the group.
- Recognise the achievements of others and applaud their success.
- Ensure that squads optimise their potential by promoting the positive aspects of sport.
- Do not condone the use of abusive language, inappropriate relationships, bullying, harassment, discrimination or physical violence.
- Never be under the influence of or drink alcoholic beverages, take illegal substances, vape or smoke prior to or whilst coaching.
- In accordance with England Netball Safeguarding Policies think twice before posting on social media.
- Only use WhatsApp groups and other social media platforms for practical issues related to netball.
- Include another appropriate adult in any communication with athletes U18 or use a group chat.
