

## **CODE OF CONDUCT – LEEDS RHINOS - PARENT/GAURDIAN**

- Conduct yourself in an honest, fair, impartial and transparent manner.
- Encourage athletes to learn the England Netball rules.
- Ensure you know the date, time and venue of training sessions and matches.
- Support your athlete to be involved in netball and enjoy their sport.
- Never force your athlete to take part in sport.
- Publicly accept officials' judgements, including coaches and administrators.
- Discourage unfair play and dissent with officials.
- Set a good example for our athletes and others to recognise fair play, and congratulate everyone on their performance.
- Please keep your opinions to yourself regarding our athletes, coaches, volunteers, opponents or officials.
- Help your athlete to recognise good performance, not just results.
- Never punish or belittle an athlete for losing or making mistakes.
- Use correct and appropriate language and behaviour at matches and in any netball context.
- Reply promptly to communication with Leeds Rhinos representatives.
- Pay fees promptly.
- Visit the website regularly for clear up to date information.
- Encourage your athlete to follow the athlete code of conduct and assist them to follow the expectations.
- In accordance with England Netball Safeguarding Policies, think twice before posting on social media.
- Only use WhatsApp groups and other social media platforms created by the coaches or Leeds Rhinos for practical issues related to netball.
